- Race Packs will be available for collection on Friday 23th November 2018 from 2.30pm – 6:00pm at Governor Phillip Reserve George St Windsor. 2018-19 SRA Log Book must be presented before collecting pack.
- Race-Safe H2O: Competitors are required to pick up a Race-Safe H2O kit from Governor Phillip Reserve George St Windsor on Friday. You will be supplied with the unit, briefed on how to fit it and instructed on how to use the device.
- A copy of the Briefing Sheets will be supplied to all competitors in their race pack and published on the website.

All competitors 13 & Over must attend official briefing or complete the online briefing for which full details will be advised after the close of entries.

- All ENGINES MUST BE SEALED with the exception of MOC, Unlimited Outboard, 60 & 70 MPH classes.
- Competitors may only enter one class in the Sunday Event.
- Only one entry per form. A separate entry form is to be completed for each class entered.
- Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded if requested in writing prior to Friday 2nd November, 2018.

Please Note:

Competitors will obey directions from all Officials as per the SRA Code of Conduct. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Un-foreseen Circumstances. NSWWSF Ltd will not be responsible for any delays or cancellation of the Event caused by a force of nature including but not limited to Acts of God, fire, war, terrorism, epidemic, earthquake, strike, bad weather, flood, labour controversy, order of court, shortage or interruptions of facilities or material supply.

Class Trophies. The committee reserves the right to reduce the number of trophies if there are less than 6 entries in a class. Trophies for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd if 6 entries in a class. 1st & 2nd only if 4 or 5 entries. Less than 4 entries 1st only.
